Icon of the Holy Family for the World Meeting of Families 2018

This icon is by iconographer Mihai Cucu, assisted by the Redemptoristine Sisters. It's in the form of a triptych which looks like a house with front doors. On these outside doors, we have the Archangels Michael and Gabriel, the protectors, with heads bowed in adoration and service of God. On the base, "Amoris Laetitia", "The Joy of the Gospel", Pope Francis' exhortation on love in the family. When the doors are opened, we see the Holy Family sharing a meal and celebrating their faith at home. Flanking them are two Gospel stories, the Raising of Jairus' Daughter and the Wedding Feast of Cana, expressing Jesus' compassion for marriage and for those living with the burdens of family life.

An icon is not like a photograph, nor is it a portrait. It is an image which invites us to prayer, in this instance inviting us to prepare our hearts for the World Meeting of Families next year.
