Church Arrangements during Dry Rot Treatment

An internal area of the Church Building is being treated for dry rot. It is a very insidious and destructive problem that requires intensive treatment with specialist chemicals.

- Weekday Masses will be in the Tara Hotel for the next four weeks, until Friday 11th July. Consult Parish Bulletin for times of Masses..
- Sunday Masses will be celebrated in the Church as usual: Vigil Mass Saturday 7pm, Sunday Masses 9am & 11am.
- Sunday Baptisms will be celebrated in the Church.
- The Church will remain open during the works except during the latter part of next week when the dry rot chemicals are being applied. Please remain clear of the scaffolding and the work area at all times.
- This Monday the drilling of the wall will begin and if the noise becomes unbearable, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament may have to be suspended for a few hours.
- The Adoration Room will remain open for the next few weeks with the Blessed Sacrament reserved and candle shrine.

It is unfortunate that such disruption to our place of worship has occurred after such an extended period of restorative work. Please God, it will all be behind us soon
