## The Painting of the Holy Family

It was a moving, significant and joyful occasion on Friday evening when our treasured painting was unveiled and blessed, returning home after being in London for restoration for the last four years. Caterina Goodhart, the restoration artist, and her husband Christopher gave us an excellent insight into the history and the mystery of the Killybegs 'Murillo'.

An unfinished work dating back to the late 17th century or early 18th century, it was completed by Spanish artist Stephanie Seron in the late 1830s. Acquired by Killybegs landlord Alexander Murray, who was Member of Parliament in Westminster 1838 - 1845, he gifted it to St Mary's Church at its official opening in 1844. It hung in the church until the mid-1930s and put in permanent storage in the church tower when the church ceiling was about to be replaced. It remained there uncared for until May 2011 and as the most recent restoration of the church was beginning it was sent to London for restoration. Caterina and her team brought it back to life through her professionalism and expertise and with great care, patience, perseverance and prayer.

The unveiling was performed by Moira Mallon and Charlie Boyle, who remember the painting hanging in the church in their earlier days, located where the Confession Box currently stands.
