Feast Day of St Catherine of Alexandria

Stained Glass Window Installation

- A three-panel Stained Glass Window entitled 'God the Father' has been installed above St Catherine's Altar and will be unveiled this Friday 7.00pm 25th November at a Mass celebrating the Feast of St Catherine of Alexandria. All are welcome.
- The window is signed 'Harry Clarke Stained Glass Ltd'. Harry Clarke (1889-1931) was Ireland's greatest stained-glass artist. In the 1960s The Harry Clarke Studios designed the 'God the Father' window for a church in New Zealand but was never delivered for whatever reason. It was purchased at public auction by Eugene Collins of Downings Antiques on behalf of Killybegs Parish last year.
- This striking, cosmic figure of God the Father will be a worthy addition to our church, complementing the Holy Family Painting above Our Lady's Altar.
- Two other stained glass windows will be unveiled in the Adoration Room that same evening.
