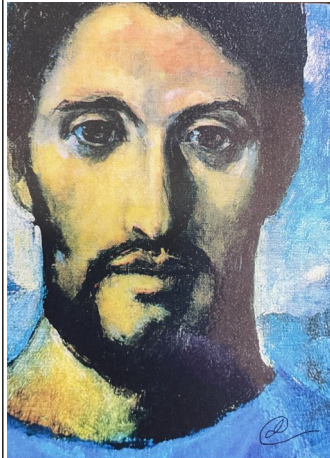
Father, into your hands we commend ourselves and place our lives, our journey and our home into your safe keeping. This we ask in Jesus' name, Amen.
