Mass Intentions and Mass Stipends

In this parish we are accustomed to having Mass offered for one intention only, be it for the dead or the living. Many intentions can be prayed for at any one Mass but traditionally Mass is designated for one intention, for which a stipend is accepted. It is permissible, however, to designate a Mass for a number of intentions on two conditions:

- That those who give the intention know that their loved ones will be remembered in a groupintentioned Mass (a shared Mass)
- That one stipend only is kept for that Mass (the remaining stipends to be donated to charity). We intend to introduce Grouped Intentions from

1st January 2016 and intend to proceed as follows:

- Our existing arrangement will continue until 31st December 2015
- Any intention taken from now on for 2016 will be with the understanding that it may be a shared Mass. This applies to Saturday 7pm Mass (for the deceased, up to three intentions) and one week-day Mass (for the living)
- Any intention already accepted for 2016/2017 will be honoured as a single intention Mass.
- We will continue to include the names of all the deceased in the Parish Newsletter as requested.
- Only one stipend will be kept by the priest for a shared Mass. The remaining stipends will go to St. Mary's Restoration Fund.

The reason for the new arrangement is the demand for Anniversary Masses for the deceased, especially for week-end Masses. Also, many intentions have to be passed on to other priests. That will still continue but many more intentions can be designated for Masses celebrated in our own chapel.

We hope this new arrangement will be acceptable.
